

FPAC proposed criterion for defining when attraction spill for the two adult ladders below the spillway at Bonneville Dam is required during the winter.

1. The number of adults migrating per day is defined as the number of upstream counts minus the number of downstream counts.
2. A three-day moving average will be used to determine if the few migrating wild adult steelhead criterion has been met.
3. The few migrating wild adult steelhead criterion is defined as less than 10 returning wild adult steelhead passing Bonneville Dam per day, during the three-day average period.
4. If a running three-day average of 10 or more returning wild adult steelhead are passing Bonneville Dam, then attraction spill will be provided for the next three day period.
