Folks,

Here are the results for day 12. We got word to stay open longer just in time. We trapped from 07:00 to 14:00. The water temperature was 68.0F at 07:00, and 68.6F at 14:00. The fish movement was very slow today. We biosampled 43 Chinook (20 clipped, 23 not clipped) and 25 steelhead (7 clipped, 18 not clipped). The fish looked good, especially the steelhead. We thought a couple of Chinook might have been falls.

They were very bright and lively! A total of 4 sockeye were trapped.

Only three were shipped out with the IDFG truck. One we got after the NPT truck got here. It is being held in the kelt tank for transportation tomorrow.
