Dear Mr. Whiteaker:

This is in response to your January 16, 2013 letter requesting approval for access to Bonneville Dam's Adult Fish Facility (AFF) for the purpose of sampling adult Chinook, sockeye, and steelhead. This is a continuation of annual sampling activities. Sampling is expected to occur one to five days a week beginning in mid-March and continuing through the end of October. As you know, you will be required to follow all protocols found in the current Fish Passage Plan (FPP) Appendix G- AFF protocols for Bonneville Dam. In addition, you will need to comply with all reporting requirements found in the current FPP section BON 3.3.3.

You are also requesting access for the purpose of continuing annual sea lion hazing activities. It is understood those details were submitted with the requests from WDFW and ODFW.

With respect to the work outlined above, your request is generally approved, provided you are able to obtain all necessary ESA and state permits. **No work may begin until permits, or an explanation as to why permits are not required, are on file with the Mr. Andy Traylor and Ms. Tammy Mackey.**


