Dear Mr. James and Mr. Jackson:

This is in response to your April 17, 2013 letter requesting approval for access to The Dalles Dam from June through September for the purpose of collecting up to 723 adult Pacific lamprey (*Entosphenus tridentata*) as part of the on-going project to restore lamprey to the tribes' 'ceded waters. This project is funded by the Bonneville Power Administration and managed by the CTUIR. Please coordinate with the Project when planning your location for traps off the face of the dam and behind the count station picket leads. Locations will need to be coordinated with FPOM as well.

With respect to the work outlined above, your request is generally approved, provided you are able to obtain all necessary ESA and state permits. **No work may begin until valid and current permits, or an explanation as to why permits are not required, are on file with the Mr. Paul Keller and Ms. Tammy Mackey.**

Prior to beginning work, please arrange a meeting with Mr. Paul Keller, 541-298-7509. You will need to provide a Project impact statement, job hazard analysis, copies of permits, and a personnel list. Please send electronic copies of these documents to Mr. Paul Keller, [Paul.S.Keller@usace.army.mil](mailto:Paul.S.Keller@usace.army.mil) and Ms. Tammy Mackey, [Tammy.M.Mackey@usace.army.mil](mailto:Tammy.M.Mackey@usace.army.mil).

Please remain in contact with Mr. Paul Keller throughout your time at the dam. There are many researchers and contractors working in the area, please work to ensure good communication and cooperation between agencies and organizations. As in past years, USACE anticipates CTUIR will work with the Nez Perce and Warm Springs tribes to help with their lamprey collection efforts, if asked.
