Dear Mr. Rose:

This is in response to your May 28, 2013 letter requesting approval to collect American shad (*Alosa sapidissima*) that are collected as a by-product of sampling by CRITFC at the Bonneville Dam (BON) Adult Fish Facility (AFF). It is understood that Yakama Nation is embarking in a White sturgeon (*Acipenser transmontanus*) broodstock collection in the lower Columbia River and that *A. sapidissima* used as bait substantially improves your collection abilities.

This is also in response to your April 22, 2013 letter requesting approval for access to Bonneville Dam (BON) to collect up to 238 Pacific lamprey (*Entosphenus tridentata*) from June to August 2013. It is understood that this collection is for your project to restore *E. tridentata* to the Yakima River and other subbasins within the tribes' Ceded Lands. Your proposal states that a key component to restoring lampreys to the Yakama Nation Ceded Lands is to collect adults from lower Columbia River dams for translocation to these various subbasins.

Please note, NOAA Fisheries in conjunction with the University of Idaho will be responsible for the AFF, NDE, and LPS traps, collecting lamprey and distributing lamprey not needed for research. Please coordinate with BON when planning your location for traps off the face of the dam. Locations will need to be coordinated with FPOM as well.


With respect to the work outlined above, your request is generally approved, provided you are able to obtain all necessary ESA and state permits. **No work may begin until permits, or an explanation as to why permits are not required, are on file with the Mr. Andy Traylor and Ms. Tammy Mackey.**

Prior to beginning work, please arrange a meeting with Mr. Andy Traylor, 541-374-4020. You will need to provide a Project impact statement, job hazard analysis, copies of permits, and a personnel list. Please send electronic copies of these documents to Mr. Traylor, Andrew.W.Traylor@usace.army.mil and to Ms. Tammy Mackey, tammy.m.mackey@usace.army.mil.

Please remain in contact with Mr. Traylor throughout your time at the dam. There are many researchers and contractors working at the dam, please work to ensure good communication and cooperation between agencies and organizations. In addition to coordinating with Project Fisheries, you will also coordinate collection activities at the AFF with John Whiteaker, whij@critfc.org.
