This is in response to your February 16, 2016 letter requesting approval for access to Bonneville Dam and the Juvenile Monitoring Facility (JMF). It's understood that you plan to conduct a separation-by-code (SbyC) recapture and collection of biological data from juvenile wild Chinook salmon and juvenile wild and hatchery Steelhead Trout. This study is funded by the COE Walla Walla District.

With respect to the work outlined above, your request is generally approved, provided you are able to obtain all necessary ESA and state permits. No work may begin until permits, or an explanation as to why permits are not required, are on file with Ms. Ida Royer and Ms. Tammy Mackey.

Prior to beginning work, please arrange a meeting with Ms. Ida Royer, 541-374-2541. Please remain in contact with Ms. Royer throughout your time at the dam. There are many researchers and contractors working at the dam; please work to ensure good communication and cooperation between agencies and organizations.
