



## SCIENTIFIC COLLECTOR'S PERMIT

1. This Scientific Collector's Permit is issued by authority of the Yakama Nation pursuant to its status as a self-regulatory manager of fish and wildlife resources within its ceded lands.
2. The undersigned agencies, entities, or persons are authorized to take fish and wildlife species listed below for scientific purposes only, subject to the conditions of this permit.
3. This permit is non-transferable. Agencies, entities, or persons not listed on this permit may not collect fish and wildlife species under authority of this permit.
4. A report of take must be completed and returned to the tribal Fisheries Resource Management Program at termination of sampling activities.

### CONDITIONS:

**Location, species and number to be taken:** Adult Pacific lampreys will be collected from May through September 2016 using the existing adult lamprey trap located in the Bonneville Washington Shore fish ladder at the Adult Fish Facility (AFF). A maximum of 860 lampreys will be collected at this location according to CRITFC member tribe adult lamprey collection guidelines.

**Disposition of catch:** Trapped fish will be held in existing equipment located within the AFF following existing methods and protocols. Adult lamprey will be held at the AFF until CRITFC member tribe personnel arrive for transfer to tribal transport vehicles which will occur within 48 hours of collection.
