FPP Section: Appendix G. Adult Facility Operating Protocols – Bonneville Dam.

Justification for Change: To alleviate confusion towards “sampling” in the context of salmonid sampling and lamprey “trapping” that occurs at the BON AFF.

Proposed Change:

1.4. Trapping Protocols – Ladder Water Temperatures $\geq 70^{\circ}\text{F}$.

1.4.2. At water temperatures of 70–72°F, sampling will be permitted as defined below for up to four days per week from 0600-1030 hours to allow for *U.S. v Oregon* requirements and for nighttime lamprey trapping. This operation will remain in effect until daily average water temperatures drop to $\leq 69.9^{\circ}\text{F}$. All sampling and nighttime lamprey trapping will cease when temperatures reach 72°F. No sampling or lamprey trapping may resume until daily average water temperatures drop to $\leq 71.9^{\circ}\text{F}$.

Comments from others:

8/13/15 FPOM: Lorz checked with B. McIlraith, otherwise FPOM was fine. Lorz came back and said McIlraith thought there was a different change form being developed. Fredricks expressed concern about how the lamprey trap operates and he believes it could trap salmon.
